Math Proficiency Requirements	<ul> <li>[SOE] The SCAA has approved the new math proficiency requirements and we are looking forward to receive UE approval on this matter.</li> <li>[AU] Our current math proficiency standard test (based on BC) is still using the Accuplacer NG-QAS. However, since we are no longer with BC, we wanted to simplify the math standard. So, for students to reach the college readiness level for Math standard, instead of doing 2 tests, they can just take the NG-AAF level math.</li> <li>[AU] For the score, students need &lt;237 for extended college algebra for all study program, ≥245 for Pre-calculus and trigonometry, ≥250 for Calculus for Business and ≥276 for Calculus and Analytical Geometry 1.</li> <li>[SDL] This policy will be used starting in March?</li> <li>[AU] Yes, we propose to start using the new Math Standard by March 1<sup>st</sup> 2024.</li> </ul>	Will issue Rector's Decree and forward to University Senate. NECHE Update	<ul> <li>[MS] Dr. Clarke and I met with NECHE on Monday night and we discussed a timeline for our next accreditation visit. At the staff level, we have support to have the visit in Fall 2025 (18 months from now) and there will be no interim report. We need to collect data and have a complete data set until Spring 2025. I will be sending a letter next week requesting the accelerated visit.</li> <li>[MS] NECHE will send about 7-8 members to conduct the visit and will be chaired by a university president.</li> </ul>			
MBA Study Program	<ul> <li>[MS] To offer the MBA, we need to get approval from the Ministry. To offer the degree under NECHE accreditation, we will have to go through a process called a Substantive Change Process. When we have our site visit in Fall 2025, it is possible that we will have a visitor who will only be looking at the level change for the MBA graduate program.</li> <li>[MS] The requirement for this site visit is that you have students enrolled in the program. So we have to start the program, and have student enrolled at the time of that visit. Otherwise, we will have to complete the Substantive Change process independent of the site visit for Initial Accreditation.</li> </ul>

Admission	<ul> <li>[MS] We have 65 kids that are admissible in the EAP right now. With Broward exiting, the new partner we're looking at is the University of North Florida (UNF). You don't have to provide placement test scores for the UNF.</li> <li>[MS] All the students are going to be admitted to UNF as NDOS (Non-Degree Objective Students). They will need to submit an application, payment and secondary school transcript.</li> <li>[MS] Florida has a common course numbering system, so the course codes at UNF are the same as at BC.</li> </ul>
