SU Budget & HR Cost	 [MS] We met last week and we went over our budget, we're contemplating some of the cost we will discuss today, what the impact will be. We need to find a way to communicate this impact with the entire SU community. [RTA] Number for paying students is increase, but net revenue is decrease due to the discount we gave to new students. The donor fund from HMS is gradually decreasing. The non-instructional cost has slightly increased by 3%, marketing and recruitment costs also decreased. [EW] The impact of our 24/25 budget is that there will be some adjustment of the HR Cost as mentioned in our meeting last week. [LS] Next year we have to achieve 200 higher targets, with lower discounts and slightly higher prices. We are going to do flat rate and no dean's scholarship or cash back. If students get the merit award, that would be applied for the whole 4 years. We propose the merit award be within the range of 50% for single degree and 25% max for double degree. 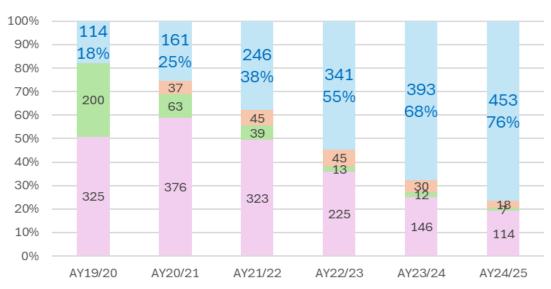

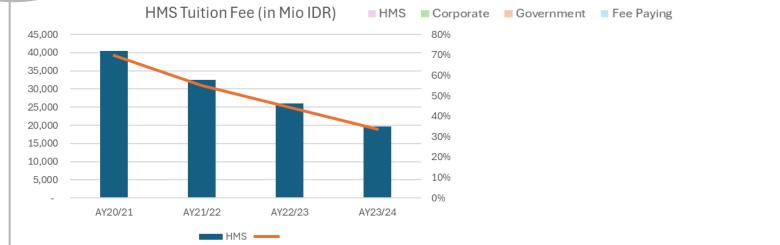

Composition by source of fund

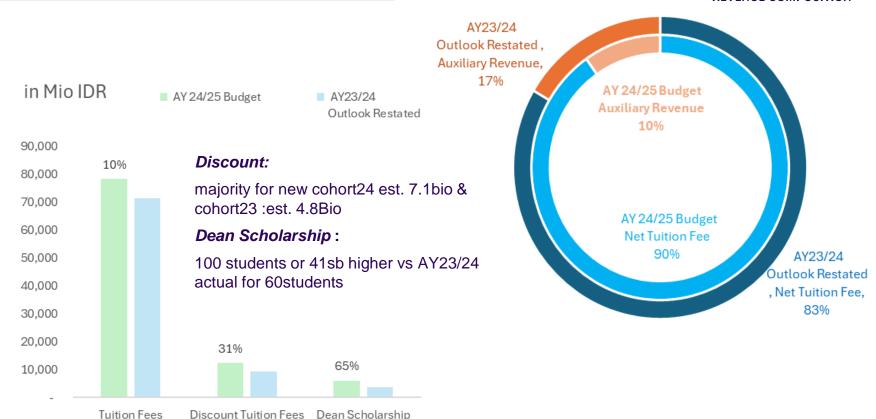
